## Our Focus for 2007 by The President

This Focus for 2007 was first delivered as an Address to the 87th BIWF Annual Congress at Newbury on 8th October, 2006

### THE WAY AHEAD (a concise outline)


Our Message is clear:  
The Full Gospel of the Kingdom  
– a unique teaching to the  
nation. It is the oil of  
understanding and it is  
received by a revelation of The  
Holy Spirit.

The Resistance is also clear:  
That satanically-inspired  
principalities and powers  
promote deception to destroy  
the Israel Company of Nations  
and the Davidic Throne, in order  
to destroy the Kingdom of God  
on Earth (Eph.6:12).

The Purpose of the BIWF –  
This is a Federation of the  
British-Israel-World  
Organizations which grew  
during the second half of the  
19th century in the UK and  
came together in 1919 to  
proclaim the Gospel of the  
Kingdom, as a Servant People  
and Company of Nations in  
co-operation.

Our Aims and Objects – are  
to project a balanced Kingdom  
Truth to the family of Covenant  
Nations, as opposed to the  
United Nations Organisation or  
the Aryan Nations group, which  
do not convey the true  
God-inspired worldwide  
Kingdom message.

The Master Plan – The True  
Gospel and its fullness. Can we  
expect to continue as a  
Federation or an Association  
when our numbers have been  
gradually declining over the  
decades? What do we need to  
do that we have not been  
doing? (In one important  
respect, the answer to changing  
the decline into an increase is  
out of our hands. It will be the  
Lord's doing.)



The Mystery of the  
Kingdom is a revelation: how  
do we convey or convince  
people of a true revelation? This  
is the key question for us.

We witness and sow the  
seed – in this we cannot  
demand from our efforts  
immediate results. We can only  
work with the people that the  
Lord calls and to whom He  
reveals the mystery – also let us  
not forget that timing is all  
important to our witness.

With the Victorian Empire  
era came The Elijah Message:  
the Gospel of the Kingdom  
since 1840 has fulfilled the  
promise that was to bring  
restoration with our historic  
inheritance as the servant  
people, but the Rome-style  
replacement theology of the  
Gospel of the Church has been  
a constant deception and  
remains today as the main  
obstacle preventing  
understanding by Christians  
generally.

The Hunting Season (Jer.  
16:16) is characteristic of The  
Elijah Message and it was to  
happen before the coming of  
the Day of the Lord at which

time there would be a falling  
away from the Faith. Crucially, it  
would not prevent the falling  
away and the Day of the Lord  
itself. In other words, the  
generation of His people living  
at this time are given their  
opportunity to receive and  
believe the Kingdom message –  
but deception and unbelief  
inspired by the father of lies has  
stood in the way of a general  
acceptance of this great  
message and truth and still  
does to this day.

There have been Three  
Great Deceptions with which  
we have had to deal during the  
past century –

1) Replacement theology,  
or the teaching that God has  
replaced Israel with the Church  
as his Kingdom people. These  
false teachers are made  
embarrassed by the Jewish  
remainder in the world, not  
understanding where the Jews  
fit within God's Master Plan.  
Linked to this Romish  
theological legacy have been  
two schools of Jesuit - inspired  
prophecy of the Book of the  
Revelation of Jesus Christ to the  
Apostle John. These are the

2) The creation of the State of Israel, claiming to be all Israel with the right to all the lands promised to Jacob-Israel. This hybrid State – a conquest of Palestine by immigration – has provoked nothing but conflict with the Arab Mideast since 1948. The Jewish-only Israel school of prophecy is now looking increasingly confused by calling for repentance by Britain, as true Israel, for reneging upon the (Zionist inspired) Balfour Declaration of Nov 2, 1917. They claim this "resulted in an untold number of Jews being unable to escape Hitler's Final Solution."\* In fact the Declaration made clear that it was the protection of the Palestinian people that was all important, i.e. "nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine."

3) The Rise of the European Union and the betrayal of Britain-Israel's sovereignty to a system that owes its origin to ancient Babylon. Globalisation has also transported this generation, through huge technological advance, to a world where borders nationally, culturally and spiritually have been broken down – all this makes us wonder how the Master Plan will be brought to final perfection.

What are the great immovable and certain factors in The Way Ahead to maintain our utter faith and confidence in God's Master Plan?

### 1) The unbreakable

"The stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken."

Covenants of Jehovah with His Servant people. They are all constant beneath the surface. We observe an overruling Providence in the affairs of

mankind and nations that gives us the peace and surety of faith. This is an outstanding characteristic of British Israelites, who see all around them in the nation crumbling, yet remain immovable in their confidence that the Covenants of Almighty God with His people will remain in place. British Israelites, above all other Christians, have faith in God and in the continuity of His great purpose for the nation of His calling.

"He hath weighed the world in the balance, and has measured the times with a measure, and carefully counted the hours, and he will not move or disturb them, until the prescribed

Esdras 4:36-37

2) The fact that the Servant People, as "the Israel of God", will remain in the Earth, not only as a group of called-out people, like the Church, but as a nation-state Kingdom and a company of nations (Jer. 31:35-37). Without this understanding of the Old and New covenants, the Bible remains veiled. The Reformation opened the eyes of the people when the Holy Bible was printed in English. The 1611 King James Version was the culmination of that resurrection process. Let us work and pray that a further opening of the eyes of God's Servant People will occur by 2011 – how marvellous if a British-Israel Bible were to be printed! Our Daily Bible Readings for 2006 and 2007, by Mary Harper, gives us a flavour of what might be possible in this respect – please study these.

3) That a Royal Throne will be in our midst, and will endure as the sun (Psa. 89:35-36). If we consider our history in these Appointed Isles, then there have been significant periods when, had we lived in those periods, we might have wondered if God's covenant to uphold the Throne would be

kept. The constitutional position of the British Monarchy has, since the European Communities Act 1972, entered a state of eclipse in which a great shadow of darkness has passed over the brilliance of the Sovereignty of the Lord's Throne upon earth (Matt. 24:29). This involves the sovereignty of 'The Queen-in-Parliament' and also of our Courts. Thus the sun of Sovereignty is darkened and as a consequence the moon, or our Courts at Law, are not giving forth light. This symbolism is emphasized by the description that "The stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken." We sometimes wonder if things can get any worse – and then they do! The point for us to keep constantly in mind is that a total eclipse endures for a relatively short period of time. We are able to look beyond the present eclipse of the Kingdom authority in the Earth and the darkness, to the moment when the pagan falsehood shall be destroyed with the brightness of His Coming.

4) The Appearance of the Sign of the Son of Man in heaven and the sending forth of His angels who "shall gather His Elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other" (Matt. 24:30-31). These winds are obviously winds of conflict that threaten the Elect, or else why would His angels need to go forth at all? It is a global threat represented by the four winds, north, south, east and west. An unclean spirit is coming forth from the mouth of the False Prophet (Rev. 16:13), evidenced in the global Islamic terrorism, now a major threat to the Christian-Israel nations. Allah is not Jehovah and the unclean spirit coming out of Islam is not The Holy Spirit. We need discernment.

5) The Return of Our Lord is as certain as the dawn tomorrow. Could anything be more explicit, powerful and full

II Thess. 2:3-12.

6) The overthrow of the resistance will mean that the truth will be heard of and believed. We cannot today conceive the kind of heaven upon earth that will come about when evil is bound. At the moment evil is in the ascendant, so many strange and violent events are taking place; it is the "terror within" of Deut. 32:25. Satan in this evil is now visible in our midst because he knows that he has only a short time in which to make a bid for total control of the servant people and their destiny. Rev. 12:12 reads: "for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time." This is where the chronological pattern confirms the truth of what we know and believe. There is a set time and an overruling Providence that is out there and which will not disappoint us. It will surely come for we are assured in II Esdras 4: 36-37 that "He hath weighed the world in the balance, and has measured the times with a measure, and carefully counted the hours, and he will not move or disturb them, until the prescribed measure is reached." Yet of even greater assurance are the concluding words of the Apostle Paul to the Christian-Israel believers of the Dispersion at Thessalonica. After revealing that the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders would be destroyed by the illuminating brightness of the Lord's Coming, Paul says a wonderful thing, that we are –

7) Chosen from the beginning for this work and witness, for he says "But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: Whereunto

he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ" (II Thess. 2: 13-14). We also now have impressive scientific evidence for our teaching. When will the penny drop with our people in general? Most certainly the last group to wake up will be the Organised Church.

What are our Main Objectives at this crucial period of history?

4) To build membership into an active base for expansion and influence.

5) To provide positive guidance for the people as to our destiny as a nation and company of nations when we emerge from the European

Union, as we surely will.

What can you all do to help?

1) Maintain a lively interest in events. Send in to us press items and reports of significance that we may not have seen. Most importantly, if you do, always put the publication date on them.

2) Use our new Monthly Prayer Diary to pray with intelligence to the God of Jacob-Israel that He will help us in our aims and objects and lead us as a nation once more into the paths of Righteousness.

3) Watch for opportunities to contact people, either by speaking to them or by using the literature which we will provide. If possible try to get them to join as Members or as Associates, or even as supporters by taking our magazine.

4) Write letters and, if you have the internet, send emails to the media on issues that will bring out the British-Israel perspective on things.

5) Encourage each other and us in the administration, so much the more as we see the day of the Lord's Return approaching.

6) Think positively: we will welcome your constructive comments.

7) Invest in the work and witness of the BIWF. In whatever way you are able, take this work to heart and let the Lord make your feet sound throughout the land like an army marching on the camp of the enemy.

The world is facing the Global Warming crisis and as it was in the days of Noah, the waters may rise again to threaten a new Flood, but the rainbow promise remains in the sky. Instead of destroying the Earth and His Servant People, He has promised a restored order of creation and a resurrection to eternal life. Are we ready and watching for that Day?

## The British-Israel-World Federation Its Place Within the Christian Fellowship

As an educational society, the Federation sets forth the central theme of the whole Bible. It proclaims both the Gospel of individual salvation and the Gospel of the Kingdom, as taught by our Lord Himself; and it demonstrates that these two aspects of the Christian faith, while remaining interdependent and inseparable, are nevertheless not identical but complementary parts of what St. Paul described as the whole counsel of God.

Lest there should be any misunderstanding, let it be stated in the clearest possible terms that the Federation proclaims the risen, ascended, living Christ as the only Saviour of all mankind, irrespective of nationality, race or colour. The individual Israelite, no less than the individual Jew and Gentile, must look to Him alone for forgiveness of sin, and for the hope of everlasting life.

While the Federation never fails to present the Lord Jesus as the Saviour of the world, it also proclaims Him as the Redeemer of the lost sheep of the House of Israel; and, in doing so, it bears witness to the truth that on the Cross of Calvary God's Servant Nation, which had been cast out of His service for its infidelity, was recommissioned to carry the whole Gospel – that is to say, both the good news of individual salvation and also the good news of His promised Kingdom – to all the families of the earth.

In other words, British Israel Truth unifies the teaching of

the Scriptures; it enlarges the field of Christian vision; and it reveals God's great plan of salvation, both on the spiritual and also on the material plane. Because of its essential simplicity as an exposition of Holy Writ, British Israel Truth provides a common meeting-ground for all denominations of the Protestant Faith, where the unhappy divisions of the Church of Christ may be laid aside in the warmest fellowship.

It must not be supposed, however, that the Federation has any desire to draw its adherents away from the Churches of their choice. On the contrary, it is the declared ambition and purpose of this society to send its members back to their own places of worship with their faith renewed, refreshed and strengthened by closer acquaintance with the Word of God.

Thus it will be seen that the Federation is both undenominational and interdenominational, advocating the specific doctrine of no particular sect, but seeking so far as it may to serve the whole Church of Christ, by contending earnestly for 'the faith which was once delivered unto the saints'.

### Israel in the Book of Common Prayer

In the Venite we sing, "We are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand." Ezekiel (xxxiv. 6) refers to Israel



as "my sheep"; and God several times acknowledges Israel as His people (Ex. vi. 7, Deut. iv. 20, Jer. xiii. 11).

In the Te Deum; "O Lord, save Thy people, and bless Thine heritage"; Isa. liv. 17 (to Israel), "No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper... This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord."

Benedicite; "O let Israel bless the Lord."

Benedictus; "Blessed be the Lord God of Israel: for he hath visited and redeemed his people; and hath raised up a mighty salvation for us..." "O Israel... return unto me; for I have redeemed thee" (Isa. xlv. 22). "O Israel, fear not: for I have redeemed thee... thou art mine" (Isa. xliii. 1) – see reference to Galatians, last chapter. "To perform the mercy promised to our forefathers." "To perform the oath which he sware to Our forefather Abraham: that he would give us."

Jubilate Deo; "We are His people, and the sheep of His pasture" (see Venite).

Magnificat; "He remembering His mercy, hath holpen His servant Israel: as He promised to our forefathers, Abraham, and his seed, for ever."

Nunc Dimittis; "To be a light



In the responses, we pray, "Make Thy chosen people joyful. O Lord, save Thy people: and bless Thine inheritance." Israel were the only people ever called God's chosen people.

In one of the collects for Good Friday, we pray that all Jews, Turks, Infidels, and Heretics may be saved among the remnant of the true Israelites.

The Psalms, portions of which we sing or say every service, Sunday or week-day, are teeming with references to Israel, notably xiv. 7, xxv. 22, and cvii. 2-7. In at least thirteen other Psalms we find references to Israel, and acknowledge, sometimes indirectly, some of them as referring to us.

In the service of prayer with thanksgiving to be used on the day of accession of our Sovereign, one of the prayers include these words: "And that these blessings may be continued to after-ages, let there never be one wanting in his (or her) house to succeed him (or her) in the government of this United Kingdom, that our posterity may see his children's children, and peace upon Israel. So we that are Thy people, and sheep of Thy pasture, shall give Thee thanks for ever..."

Designing and programming of the websites, for the BIWF-USA and the Covenant Publishing Company of North America, is no easy task. I have to teach myself from computer books. It would be nice to have the finances to employ outside services, but lacking the funding, I have taken on this responsibility. No complaints however!! It is my belief that it is the responsibility of the President to give direction, motivation and to be the overseer, not in the role of a dictator but one who supports

the membership.

I envision BIWF-USA growing into a dynamic organisation over the next couple of years. The USA is so large that one can foresee the need to break it up into various territories, headed-up by Deputy Presidents. This will of course require people who share the same vision. There appears to be no reason why BIWF-USA should not grow to a membership of over five-hundred within the next 18 months to 2 years. The main limitation at present is the financial one, as I cannot continue to finance it alone.

The BIWF-USA needs to position itself on Kingdom principles regarding the Israel Teaching, keeping aside; those that wish to see only the Identity issue. It is the balanced middle ground which needs to be reclaimed.

We pray that the power of the Holy Spirit will be upon us concerning the growth of the BIWF-USA.

# RALLY TO MARK HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN'S 80th BIRTHDAY

Saturday 10th June, a beautiful summer's day, was chosen for a Rally at Headquarters to coincide with the original date of H. M. The Queen's official birthday, and about thirty members and friends arrived at 121, Low Etherley at 11am when tea and coffee were served.

At 11:30 the President, Mr MJ Browning, welcomed everyone and said: "We have set this day apart that we might especially give thanks to our Heavenly Father for His mercy in bringing Elizabeth our Queen, of the Royal House of David, safely to this hour of grace; and in this act of worship and reflection to demonstrate and acknowledge that same blessed love and care embracing ourselves and all those associated with us who could not be here in person. In 1970 I wrote my first letter to Her Majesty, the subject being the Common Market, and since then I have written to her in the region of ninety letters, some on behalf of the Federation, others sent privately, quite apart from sending loyal greetings from our conventions: all expressing love and devotion to the Lord's anointed, to David's Royal House, and to the Lord's Throne on which The Queen sits as Regent."

We sang the three verses of the National Anthem and the hymn: Judge Eternal, throned in splendour and the President offered a short prayer for blessing on this special day. He read his letter sent to The Queen and the reply received as follows:

May it please Your Majesty,

Here at our Headquarters in Low Etherley, Bishop Auckland, on the 10th June, 2006, Officers

and Members of our Federation will foregather for thanksgiving in celebration of the eightieth anniversary of your birth. Truly, 1926 has proved to be of a unique vintage and it is of more than passing interest that this 53rd year of your reign since your Coronation in 19(53) heralds in the completion of your eightieth year, in the fullness of life a new and strengthening witness to the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ and His coming Kingdom, through God our Heavenly Father.

In his lecture entitled: The Miraculous Kingdom, Mr MA Clark, Deputy President, quoted Deuteronomy 33: 17, Zephaniah 3: 10-19 (key verse 19) and Matthew 12: 42 – God's prophecies fulfilled throughout the centuries, and we considered the origins of the Kingdom plan and the way that Almighty God brought Jacob-Israel into being. This history can only be understood as we appreciate His action to bring about the restoration of a perfect order destroyed when Adamic man departed from the fullness of joy in the presence of the Lord.



From page 9 Lord hath spoken we will do" (Exodus 19:8). After 'the Day of the Lord', under His guidance we shall eventually fulfil our true potential: a 'new thing' indeed.

In the afternoon, Mr RF Graham issued a call to action to combat the religious, moral, political, economic and geophysical dangers facing God's people today. Our nation must be recalled to its Divine responsibilities as God's servant people.

At 8pm, our guest speaker, Mr Adrian Gilbert, said that his investigations had led to his belief that St Paul's Cathedral and various churches ranged around it were part of a geometric plan to build a new Jerusalem in London. The town and abbey of Glastonbury, the Great Pyramid, Stonehenge and the Stone of Destiny, all bore signs of similar geometric symbolism.

Conducting the Epilogue, Mrs KD Gage said we are privileged to remind God of His promises. By resting in Him we gain peace of mind and joy of heart, strengthening our faith by studying His Word which the Book of Common Prayer tells us was 'written for our learning'.

On Wednesday, Mr MS Jarvis led our thoughts at Morning Devotions. He said our people need to discover that God, in His love, mercy and guidance, will meet all our needs and bring about changes to reverse the moral and spiritual decline. We need an Elijah ministry to prepare the way for Christ to come.

At 9:45am, Dr TBH Squire drew attention to new things in our history which led to Protestant theology that shaped national life. Much of God's New Thing is a return to that which He planned. Yesterday, today and for ever

His hand is upon history.

After coffee, Mr JM Lightfoot's illustrated lecture, based on Revelation 12, described the result of the flight of the woman (Israel) to the wilderness – the Appointed Place. Christ coming to rule with a rod of iron also compasses the Church (the manchild) which is His Body. Verse 17: There is still trouble to come. Not until Revelation 20 do we see the Kingdom of God coming on earth.

In the afternoon, Mr MA Clark's lecture, commencing with Daniel 11: 40-45 and Revelation 16: 13-16, covered the activity of the four winds (Ezekiel 37:9, noting Matthew 24:31); global activation, pressures of excessive migration of peoples, terrorism, political and religious correctness, increasing Muslim threat and a growing global Chinese power: all coming to the point of a great storm, "the time of Jacob's trouble" but "he shall be saved out of it." Our hope is not in vain. True Israel will be resurrected.

Conducting the Covenant Service, the Rev Barrie Williams said it is only when we turn to God that we reflect His image. We are only shattered mirrors, but even a shattered mirror can

become a reflection of a thing of great beauty. What a great privilege this is.

After all had received the Bread and Wine, the final hymn was: Praise, my soul, the King of Heaven, and Rev Williams gave The Blessing. A short healing session was held for those who had requested this.

Leading our thoughts at the final Morning Devotions, Mr AE Linnegan spoke of the holiness of God, free from all limitation in His perfection, which condemns us for our sinfulness. Jesus, the Saviour, demonstrated that at the heart of holiness is love, the grace of God available to all who follow Him.

Giving the concluding lecture, Mr FE Tebbutt said neglect of our nation's history has resulted in our present deplorable condition. God's plans, though frustrated by man, always come to fruition. The deliverance and restoration of Israel will be life from the dead, when God pours out His Spirit upon His people.

After coffee, the Secretary outlined new things which our Federation hopes to achieve. He said other groups look to us for direction and encouragement. Enquiries from many countries

In a final word, the President recalled the broadcasts years ago over Radio Manx. Now, by advanced technology, we can propagate the message more widely. Let us go forward, always leaning on our God.

The Convention drew to a close, with all singing the first verse of: God be with you till we meet again; and, after lunch, we dispersed to our homes, full of thankfulness for a very happy and uplifting week.

## 87th ANNUAL CONGRESS

The 87th Annual Congress of The British-Israel-World Federation held from Friday to Monday, 6th to 9th October, was a very special event, as it marked a celebration of the long presidency, spanning 19 ½ years, of Mr Matthew J Browning who, under God, has guided the Federation through both difficult and pleasant events during that period.

The Ramada Hotel, Elcot, near Newbury, Berkshire, was the inspired choice of our Secretary, Pastor DJ Aimer, and the 40 – 50 resident delegates, and also some day visitors, thoroughly enjoyed the very comfortable amenities, and the attentions of an excellent and friendly staff.

The overall theme of Congress, chosen by Mr MA Clark, the President-elect, was: Our British-Israel and Protestant Heritage and its meaning Today, and in their lectures all the speakers demonstrated the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

At the first meeting we were privileged to use the new re-issue of The Kingdom Hymnal. The President welcomed everyone, and brought greetings from absent Scottish friends, and from the BIWF Canada, the Canadian BI Association and from Australia. In a few opening remarks, the President emphasised our loyalty to the Throne, and urged that we pray without ceasing for Her Majesty's wellbeing.

Giving the first lecture, Mr MA Clark drew a parallel between Noah's day and our own, linked by significant time cycles. We noted Hebrews 10:25, the importance of meeting together to gain strength with which to face the future.

On Saturday afternoon, Professor MD Bennett highlighted important 'Therefores' of God which contained foundational fundamental truths, Malachi 3:6 being one of outstanding importance.

After the tea break, Miss CAJ Cream concentrated on the words: Heritage, Protestant and British-Israel. Our Christian Protestant Faith is not an invention of man, but a revelation by God in the Person of Jesus Christ, noting John 12:32.

After enjoying a Gala Dinner in honour of our President, Saturday evening was a very special occasion. In his presidential address, Mr Browning said all who claim to be of the seed of Jacob-Israel are branches of the root and

On the Arch of Titus, which commemorates the conquest of Jordan in AD70, the 7 branched candlestick, table of shewbread and silver trumpets are depicted. The Bible gives no dimensions of the candlestick, so it is interesting to note that in comparison it is approximately six feet high and has a hexagonal base. What is important is that the table of shewbread matches the Bible dimensions, therefore the candlestick would have cast light upon the 12 loaves and not a shadow.

# MUSLIMS IN GLASS HOUSES

Why is the Muslim sense of victimhood so inflated, given that many Muslim societies won't put their own houses in order? And why is this double standard downplayed so much in Britain?

Mohammad Siddique Khan, ringleader of the July 7 bombers, justified his action as revenge for the killing of Muslims by Western forces in the Middle East. Dhiren Barot, sentenced yesterday for plotting to kill thousands of civilians, gave a similar rationale for his crimes. Much has been said about the moral squalor of these comments, but far less about their sheer incoherence.

Let us grant that the invasion of Iraq was a mistake, and overlook the inconvenient fact that most Muslim deaths there are now the fault of other Muslims. Forget the equally unpalatable truth that large majorities of Muslims in Bosnia, Kosovo and Afghanistan support Western intervention in their countries. Look instead beyond Iraq and Afghanistan, back well before 9/11, and you see innumerable Christian communities on the defensive against rampant forms of Islam.

Siddique Khan and his associates were allowed to practise their religion freely in Britain, but there is scarcely a country from Morocco to Iraq in which Christians are able to worship without harassment.

Though horrifying, the carnage in Iraq is dwarfed by that of Sudan, where the Islamic Government has been responsible for killing two million Christian and other non-Muslim civilians since 1989.

Christians in Turkey, Jordan and Pakistan, among other

countries, live in regular fear of attack, and there is strong evidence that the attitudes underlying such aggression are fomented through official channels. In a recent letter to Kofi Annan, campaigners for the charity Christian Solidarity International wrote that "the role of the Saudi-based Organisation of the Islamic Conference, representing 57 Muslim states, in creating a climate for violent confrontation is a cause of deep concern".

The reason we hear so little about religious oppression in the Muslim world is straightforward: young Christians in the West don't become "radicalised", and persecuted Christians tend not to respond with violence. That should make them more worthy of attention and support, not less.
